As Bayside High School defeated Beach Channel yesterday to make the Public Schools Athletic League playoffs again, its stars of three past city champion teams were doing well on college fields.

At Ithaca, N.Y., Derrick Harmon gained 142 yards and scored three touchdowns in leading Cornell to a 34-0 rout of the Merchant Marine Academy.

He was the star of the 1979 city champions.

At Syracuse, Jaime Covington, a Bayside star in 1980, scored three times and passed for a touchdown as the Orange defeated Colgate, 49-15. Covington rushed for 192 yards, and scored on runs of 1, 12 and 14 yards.

In Iowa City, Ronnie Harmon of last year's Bayside team caught the winning touchdown pass as Iowa upset Illinois, 14-13. Harmon, the brother of Derrick, made the reception in the third quarter. In the first period, he caught a 36-yarder, which set up Iowa's other touchdown.
