Pitt coach, athletic director blast agents Walters, Bloom


University of Pittsburgh tailback Charles Gladman and defensive back Teryl Austin will miss the 1987 season because the NCAA has declared them in-

eligible, Pitt athletic director Edward Bozik and head football coach Mike Gottfried announced Friday. The Atlanta Journal and Constitution reported last week that such an announcement was imminent. Gladman and Austin were ruled ineligible for their senior seasons because they signed contracts with and accepted money from agents Norby Walters and Lloyd Bloom.

Bozik pointed out that Austin needed 12 credits and Gladman 25 to graduate and that their scholarships will now have to be terminated. Both Bozik and Gottfried blasted the agents. Said Bozik: "These two gentlemen have done significant and irreparable damage to the athletes they're involved with." Said Gottfried: "If I told you what I think of those two, I'd be sued. They're deceitful, self-righteous, and they don't care at all about these kids. Here's a guy (Bloom) who a couple weeks ago said he'd do all he could to get Teryl into the supplemental NFL draft. He doesn't care about Teryl Austin, I'll guarantee you that. The guy's a two-faced guy, that's all there is to it." Both Gottfried and Bozik said they do not condone the players' part in the matter but said they can understand why the players accepted money from the agents. The NCAA does not allow players to have part-time jobs and does not give them spending money, Gottfried and Bozik noted. Both said they will push for NCAA reforms in these areas, as well as pushing for tighter control on agents. Wa ters and Bloom are being investigated by federal authorities for their dealings with college ath-

letes. OBITUARY: Memorial services are planned for Saturday in Salem, Va., for Joseph Sandy "Buddy" Hackman, a wingback in the once-feared University of Tennessee backfield of "Hack, Mack and Dodd." He was 81. Hackman, who teamed with halfback Gene (Mack) McEver, quarterback Bobby Dodd and fullback Quinn Decker on Vol teams from 1928-30, died Thursday night at Roanoke Memorial Hospital, where he suffered a stroke June 14. Hospital officials said Hackman never regained consciousness from the stroke, which may have been brought on by a double bypass heart operation two days earlier. McEver and Dodd both made All-America and were later enshrined in the College Football Hall of Fame, but Hackman, many said, was the vital cog in the single-wing configuration that led UT, under coach Robert Neyland, to a 27-1-3 record for three seasons. Dodd became a longtime coach at Georgia Tech.

BASKETBALL: Two officials in San Juan, Puerto Rico, opposed extraditing Indiana basketball coach Bobby Knight to serve a six-month jail sentence for slugging a policeman during the 1979 Pan American Games. Former Gov. Carlos Romero Barcelo, in office when the incident occurred, said "the case is dead and finished. What's the good of putting Bobby Knight in jail? He's suffered enough." At the time, Knight was on the Caribbean is-

land of Puerto Rico, a U.S. Commonwealth, as coach of the goldmedal winning U.S. men's basketball team. Knight was convicted in San Juan District Court of slugging a Puerto Rican policeman. The other official opposing extradition was Puerto Rico's Olympic Committee president, German Rieckehoff Sampayo, also a member of the International Olympic Committee. Rieckehoff Sampayo expressed concern "that this could cause unnecessary problems for our delegation in Indianapolis" during the Pan American Games that start Aug. 8.

LEGAL: The only son of Hous-

ton Oilers owner Bud Adams was found shot to death at the family's ranch in far northwest Harris County. Kenneth Adams, 29, was found shortly after 3 p.m. by another family member. Police said the gunshot was apparently selfinflicted, but detectives are continuing the investigation. The younger Adams was a member of the board of directors of the Houston Oilers. ... Texas Attorney General Jim Mattox has warned Southern Methodist University officials through an intermediary that money paid as part of a termination agreement to three former athletic department officials may have to be repaid to the school. Mattox advised university leaders that \$863,013 in severance pay to former athletic director Bob Hitch, former football

coach Bobby Collins and Hitch assistant Henry Lee Parker may have to be returned. Hitch, Collins and Parker resigned last December in the wake of the football recruiting scandal. About \$150,000 has been paid to them so far. ... In Greeley, Colo., a University of Northern Colorado wrestler injured in a fight outside a bar remained paralyzed from the neck down, and doctors held out little hope for recovery. However, the hospital upgraded the condition of Phillip Rangel III, 19, from critical to serious. Rangel suffered broken and displaced bones in his neck during the altercation on Wednesday night. Police continue to investigate the incident, which occurred after bouncers threw Rangel out of the bar for fighting with another patron.

COLLEGES: SEC commissioner Harvey Schiller said he has no plans to move his office out of Birmingham, Ala., although he said several cities would like for him to do so. "I think that Birmingham is a good city," said Schiller, "but there are several presidents and athletic directors who would like to see us in a different location. Of course, there are those who want us to stay." Atlanta is the city mentioned most often, because of its position as an airline hub, although two Florida cities, Orlando and Tampa, are reported to have sought the SEC office.


