Signing college athletes to professional sports contracts is a violation of NCAA rules, and a grand jury probing the activities of the two agents is said to be considering whether such practices constitute fraud against the universities involved.

But the Big Ten lawsuit says simply that the league certifies its athletes' eligibility and asks that Walters and Bloom be ordered to disclose the identities of any athletes they have signed. "Our sole concern in this matter is concealment. That is a violation of Big Ten rules," attorney Byron Gregory said. "If student-athletes want to sign these contracts, that is an issue that reasonable people can resolve. If there is concealment of actions that render a player ineligible and we nonetheless continue to certify, we are in an untenable position."

About a half-dozen athletes around the nation have lost their senior year of eligibility as a result of reported dealings with Walters and Bloom. Among them are Ohio State wide receiver Cris Carter and Pitt running back Charles Gladman, both of whom have applied for the NFL's supplemental draft.

USOC Director Miller Resigns

George Miller has resigned as executive director of the United States Olympic Committee for "personal reasons." His resignation became effective Sunday upon the conclusion of the Pan American Games in Indianapolis. He will work as a USOC consultant through the 1988 Olympics in Seoul.

Miller, 57, began the job in February, 1985, replacing Col. F. Don Miller, who retired after 12 years. Baron Pittenger, USOC assistant executive director, will be acting executive director until a full-time replacement is found. A search committee will report to USOC officials at a meeting in October.

Davis Cup doubles player Ken Flach and 15-year-old Michael Chang of LaCosta, Calif., the boys-18 national champion, are among eight players receiving wild-card entries into the main draw of the U.S. Open singles competition. The others are Al Parker of Claxton, Ga.; Shelby Cannon of Gainesville, Fla.; Rich Leach of Laguna Beach, Calif.; Joey Rive of Lake Worth, Fla.; Todd Nelson of San Diego and Andrew Burrow of South Africa. Parker and Cannon are members of the Junior Davis Cup team. The Open starts next Tuesday at the National Tennis Center in Flushing Meadow.

Steffi Graf's tooth problems will keep her out of the United Jersey Bank Classic tennis tournament that opened yesterday in Mahwah, N.J. Graf, who underwent dental surgery in Florida Thursday and Friday and again last night, was scheduled to start play today. After initially postponing her match until Thursday, tournament officials received word that she will not be able to appear at all. In her absence, No. 2 seed Helena Sukova moves up to No. 1 and Zina Garrison to No. 2.
