San Diego Is Favored As America's Cup Site

The date and site of the next America's Cup race will be revealed tomorrow at a news conference at the San Diego Yacht Club, custodian of the sailing trophy by dint of Dennis Conner's victory with the club's entry, Stars & Stripes, in last February's Cup series.

Gerry Driscoll, chairman of the seven-member America's Cup Committee, which has the job of selecting the site for the international regatta, has said San Diego probably would be chosen to host the 1991 event. Conner, a native of San Diego, also has endorsed his hometown as the site for the next America's Cup.

The series is worth an estimated \$1 billion to the host city. Among the other American locales seeking the event are San Francisco; Ventura, Calif.; Hawaii, and Newport, R.I.

OSU Won't Fight for Carter

Ohio State officials announced yesterday that they will not appeal to the NCAA to restore the eligibility of Cris Carter, the all-America wide receiver whose acceptance of money from a sports agent led to his dismissal from the team. Carter last week asked the school to make such a request of the NCAA. Yesterday, after the school's refusal, he said he will make himself available in an NFL supplemental draft set for Friday.

Carter, the Buckeyes' all-time leading pass receiver, admitted he accepted a \$5,000 interest-free loan and monthly payments from agents **Norby Walters** and **Lloyd Bloom**.

Team USA Beats Sweden

Bobby Carpenter and Ed Olczyk each had a goal and an assist as the United States beat Sweden, 5-2, in Hamilton, Ontario, to move into first place in the Canada Cup tournament with a 2-0 record. Chris Nilan, Bob Brooke and Joe Mullen also scored for Team USA. Bengt Gustafsson and Mats Naslund scored for Sweden (1-1). Rangers goalie John Vanbiesbrouck was outstanding for the U.S. team in the opening period as Sweden enjoyed three power plays. There were only 4,474 spectators in Copps Coliseum, which seats 17,520. Team USA beat Finland, 4-1, in its opener.

Thiffault Named to Rangers' Staff

Charles Thiffault has been hired by the Rangers as an assistant to coach Michel Bergeron. Thiffault, who was Bergeron's assistant in Quebec, will oversee the Rangers' physical fitness program, specialty teams and video operations. . . . The Islanders have re-signed Bobby Nystrom as an assistant coach. . . . The Canucks and Flyers swapped backup goalies. Vancouver sent Wendell Young and a third-round draft pick in 1990 to Philadelphia for goalie Darren Jensen and defenseman-left wing Daryl Stanley.

Unhappiness at Miami?

University of Miami football coach Jimmy Johnson, saying his team did not need distractions with its season opener against Florida five days away, refused to comment on a report that he wants to leave the Hurricanes for an NFL job.

The Miami Herald reported that Johnson, entering his fourth year at Miami, has let NFL teams know he is interested in moving to the professional ranks. The newspaper also reported that athletic director Sam Jankovich will leave the school when his contract expires next June. The Herald quoted anonymously "sources close to the two men."

Johnson, with a 29-8 record at Miami, has a contract that runs through the 1991 season. A buy-out clause that would enable him to leave the Hurricanes without any financial liability expires after this year.

Charges Against QB Dismissed

A Common Pleas Court judge in Pittsburgh dismissed resisting arrest charges against West Virginia quarterback Major Harris after prosecutors failed to produce evidence or witnesses against him at a hearing. The 19-year-old freshman and two unidentified men allegedly threw a brick and a bottle at a police car after officers were called to break up a fraternity party.
