The date and site of the next America's Cup race will be revealed tomorrow at a news conference at the San Diego Yacht Club, custodian of the sailing trophy by dint of Dennis Conner's victory with the club's entry, Stars & Stripes, in last February's Cup series.

Gerry Driscoll, chairman of the seven-member America's Cup Committee, which has the job of selecting the site for the international regatta, has said San Diego probably would be chosen to host the 1991 event. Conner, a native of San Diego, also has endorsed his hometown as the site for the next America's Cup.

The series is worth an estimated \$1 billion to the host city. Among the other American locales seeking the event are San Francisco; Ventura, Calif.; Hawaii, and Newport, R.I.

OSU Won't Fight for Carter

Ohio State officials announced yesterday that they will not appeal to the NCAA to restore the eligibility of Cris Carter, the all-America wide receiver whose acceptance of money from a sports agent led to his dismissal from the team. Carter last week asked the school to make such a request of the NCAA. Yesterday, after the school's refusal, he said he will make himself available in an NFL supplemental draft set for Friday.

Carter, the Buckeyes' all-time leading pass receiver, admitted he accepted a \$5,000 interest-free loan and monthly payments from agents Norby Walters and Lloyd Bloom.

Team USA Beats Sweden

Bobby Carpenter and Ed Olczyk each had a goal and an assist as the United States beat Sweden, 5-2, in Hamilton, Ontario, to move into first place in the Canada Cup tournament with a 2-0 record. Chris Nilan, Bob Brooke and Joe Mullen also scored for Team USA. Bengt Gustafsson and Mats Naslund scored for Sweden (1-1). Rangers goalie John Vanbiesbrouck was outstanding for the U.S. team in the opening period as Sweden enjoyed three power plays. There were only 4,474 spectators in Copps Coliseum, which seats 17,520. Team USA beat Finland, 4-1, in its opener.
