Patriots' Back Recounts Agent's Threat, Payoffs

Patriots running back Robert Perryman testified in Chicago yesterday that sports agent **Lloyd Bloom** threatened him with possible incrimination if he refused to extend a contract agreement he'd signed earlier in violation of NCAA rules.

Perryman said **Bloom** and agent Norby Walters recruited him during the spring of 1986, his junior year at the University of Michigan, where he had a football scholarship. Perryman said the agents signed him to a post-dated contract, giving him \$2,500 cash at the time and \$240 to \$250 a month thereafter, in violation of NCAA rules.

His testimony was the fourth account from an athlete in the 4-day-old trial of Walters, 58, and **Bloom**, 29, who are accused of **fraud, extortion and racketeering.**

Earlier, Steelers cornerback Rod Woodson said Walters showed him an envelope with \$4,000 and told Woodson he could have the money if he signed a contract in violation of NCAA rules while at Purdue. Woodson said he signed a contract allowing **Walters and Bloom** to represent him in NFL negotiations, then lied to his coach and on NCAA eligibility forms.

Coach: Ben Knew What He Was Taking

Ben Johnson's lawyer focused on the quantities of vitamins and other legal substances the sprinter used, and implied his client could have been confused about banned steroids. But coach Charlie Francis, in his seventh day testifying in Toronto before the Canadian commission investigating drugs and athletics, insisted the athlete was "acutely aware of what he was taking."

Lawyer Ed Futerman, cross-examining the coach persistently for a second day, noted Johnson regularly received injections of vitamin B-12, which is not on the list of substances banned by the International Olympic Committee. Using the year 1987 as an example, Francis estimated that more than half of about 60 injections Johnson received would have been legal substances without the banned steroid furazabol added.

Francis, Johnson's only coach, has traced the sprinter's steroid use to 1981 and said it continued each year to within weeks of the 1988 Olympics. But he concluded that he could not explain the positive steroid test at Seoul that cost Johnson his 100-meter gold medal because the substance detected, stanozolol, was last used in spring, 1987.

Bengals Paying for Wilson's Rehab

The Bengals said they are paying for another drug rehabilitation program for suspended fullback Stanley Wilson, who still awaits word from the NFL on whether he will be allowed to play in the league again. Wilson checked into a drug rehabilitation clinic in Inglewood, Calif., on March 1 and was due to stay there for a week to 10 days, Bengals assistant general manager Mike Brown said. Wilson, 27, was suspended hours before the Bengals' Jan. 22 Super Bowl appearance in Miami because of evidence he had relapsed into drug use. The NFL had suspended Wilson for the 1985 and 1987 seasons because of cocaine use.

The Patriots signed free-agent placekicker Greg Davis, who spent the past two NFL seasons with the Falcons, to a two-year contract. The Patriots also came to terms with former Chiefs wide receiver Mike Jones.

Fordham Women Advance in MAAC

Theresa LaBella converted an 18-foot jumper with 2:38 remaining to break a 54-54 tie and Jeanine Radice scored four of her 31 points during a 9-2 run over the last three minutes to lead fifth-seeded Fordham (14-14) to a 63-56 win over No. 4 Manhattan (14-14) in a MAAC quarterfinal women's basketball game in Worcester, Mass. Radice, whose three-point shot at the halftime buzzer gave Fordham a 27-26 lead, also had a game-high six assists. LaBella had a career-high 13 points. Cari-Lynn Piotrowski led Manhattan with 17 points and Leigh Anne Walker had 11 rebounds. Fordham plays top-seeded La Salle in a semifinal at 5 p.m. tomorrow at Holy Cross.

Roberts Shoots 66 in Chilly Orlando

Loren Roberts battled temperatures in the low 40s and brisk winds for a 5-under-par 66 and a one-stroke lead in the first round of the \$800,000 Nestle Invitational golf tournament on Arnold Palmer's Bay Hill course in Orlando.

Nick Price, wearing gloves, a ski cap and five layers of clothing over his upper body, birdied the last three holes for a 67. Tom Kite holed a 173-yard 6-iron shot for an eagle-2 on the 16th and was tied at 68 with Ted Schulz and Tom Purtzer.

Yugoslavian manager **Goran Ivanisevic**, ranked 119th in the world, upset No. 8 seed **Andrei Chesnokov**, 4-6, 6-3, 6-3, to reach the quarterfinals of the \$415,000 Eagle Classic of Scottsdale (Ariz.) tennis tournament. Top-seeded **Ivan Lendl** eased past **Christo van Rensburg**, 6-0, 6-2, and **Jim Courier** ousted **Johan Kriek**, 6-1, 6-1 . . . Boxer **Anthony Hembrick**, who failed to appear in time for a scheduled Olympic bout in Seoul, has signed a managerial contract with **Frank Kane**, a Norfolk, Va., sports attorney, and **expects to have his first pro-light-heavyweight bout late next month in Detroit.**
