Agent's Threats Related at Trial

Bears defensive back Maurice Douglass said yesterday that sports agent Lloyd Bloom threatened to "have somebody break my legs" if Douglass stopped doing business with Bloom and fellow agent Norby Walters without returning money and cars the two had given him while he attended Kentucky.

Testifying at the two agents' federal court trial in Chicago, Douglass said that at about the time of the 1986 NFL draft, he told Walters and Bloom he wanted to retain another agent. "He [Bloom] told me that if I did not return the money and the cars he would have somebody rough me up and I might not make it to the draft," Douglass said.

Douglass said he made arrangements to reimburse Walters and Bloom about \$9,000 and gave them about half that amount after he signed with the Bears in 1986. He said that after another threatening call from Bloom, he paid back the rest.

Inquiry Broke the Silence

Canada's best sprinters would have "gone to their graves" with the secret of steroid use if the Canadian government had not ordered an inquiry into the Ben Johnson scandal, sprinter Angella Issajenko testified at the Toronto hearing. But once the inquiry was ordered and sworn statements were to be taken, she said, "there was no point in both-ering to lie — it was over."

U.S. Skater in Contention

Chris Browning of the United States and Kurt Browning of Canada moved into a virtual tie with Aleksandr Fadeev of the Soviet Union after the men's original program in the World Figure-Skating Championships in Paris. The three are so close that today's final free skating, worth 50 percent of the total score, will decide the champion.

Earlier, Ekaterina Gordeeva and Sergei Grinkov of the Soviet Union, the Olympic champions, won their third pairs title in four years. Canada's Cindy Landry and Lyndon Johnston were second and Elena Bechke and Denis Petrov of the Soviet Union third.

Newsome: I'll Be Back

Ozzie Newsome, the NFL's all-time reception leader among tight ends, said he will return for one more season with the Browns now that coach Marty Schottenheimer has been replaced by Bud Carson. Former All-Pro linebacker Otis Wilson, left unprotected by the Bears under the NFL's new free-agency system, has signed with the Raiders. Wilson, 31, played eight years with the Bears. In other signings, the 49ers picked up former Oilers tight end Jamie Williams and former Cowboys quarterback Kevin Sweeney, and the Patriots signed ex-Giant Gary Jeter, left unprotected by the Rams.

3-Time Champion Loses

Joe Runyan won the Iditarod Trail sled-dog race in Alaska, ending the three-year reign of Susan Butcher. It took Runyan and his 11 dogs slightly more than 11 days to cover the 1,168 miles from Anchorage to Nome. His wife and baby watched as he accepted \$50,000 of the \$250,000 purse to be shared by the first 20 finishers. Runyan, 40, snapped Butcher's streak, but failed by about three hours to break her 1987 record time. When he crossed the finish line, she was followed by five miles behind.

Former WBC lightweight champ Hector Camacho ran his 1987 Lotus off a fog-bound road and slammed into a palm tree near Clewiston, Fla., on Tuesday, but suffered only small cuts on his head. He was charged with careless driving. Sen. Bill Bradley (D-N.J.) said he is introducing legislation that would require colleges to disclose the graduation rates of student-athletes, the New York Times reported.
