# Agent Threatened Me, Seahawks' Woods Says

Sports agent Norby Walters told a Pitt linebacker he didn't want "to be a rat" and cause problems over the player's decision to fire him, according to a tape-recording of their conversation played yesterday at the agent's federal trial in Chicago. But the player, Tony Woods, told a U.S. District Court jury that he felt threatened by Walters, who went on to urge him to change his mind. The recording of their 1987 conversation was made by Woods, now with the Seahawks, after he was sued for \$500,000 by Walters for breaking their contract.

Walters, 58, and fellow agent Lloyd Bloom, 29, are charged with racketeering, fraud and extortion.

Woods said he signed a contract with Walters and Bloom in February, 1986, when he was a junior at Pitt, and accepted about \$10,000 in loans, plus plane tickets. Walters also loaned \$6,000 to Woods' parents, who own a house-cleaning business.

The linebacker admitted under cross-examination that he has not paid back a cent of the money to the agents, despite a \$350,000 signing bonus from Seattle in 1987.

In later testimony, Texas football players Everett Gay and Edwin Simmons told the jury about what they claimed was a threat from Bloom to have thugs break Gay's legs because he was talking about terminating his contract with the sports agents. Gay now plays for the Cowboys.

#### Canseco Aide Arrested

An employee of Athletics slugger Jose Canseco allegedly possessed steroids when he was arrested on a concealed weapons charge while trying to board a plane with Canseco. David Valdes, 24, was arrested Jan. 21 at Detroit Metropolitan Airport for allegedly possessing a loaded handgun as he and Canseco left Michigan after a baseball-card show. Valdes denied that 26 tablets found in his briefcase were steroids, saying they were "prescription pills . . . to make me gain weight and strength."

The Astros acquired second baseman Steve Lombardozzi from the Twins for a player to be named. The Astros' regular second baseman, Bill Doran, is recovering from arthroscopic knee surgery March 7. . . Former Cowboys coach Tom Landry will throw out the first pitch on opening night at Arlington Stadium on April 4, Rangers board chairman Eddie Chiles said.

### Agassi Loses in First Round

Carl-Uwe Steeb broke third-seeded Andre Agassi's serve four consecutive times and scored a straight-set upset in the first round of the International Players Championships at Key Biscayne, Fla. Steeb, ranked 96th in the world, won, 6-4, 7-5, 6-0, taking the final eight games. Agassi, ranked fourth, is the first seed to be ousted from the two-week, \$2.1-million tournament.

Agassi said he had never heard of the 21-year-old West German. "I had no idea whether he was lefthanded or righthanded or anything," Agassi said. "I didn't know his name."

Steeb responded: "Maybe he knows it now."

#### LIers Big Winners in Track Contest

Officials of the Northfield (Ohio) Park harness track confirmed they are checking circumstances that resulted in \$120,000 in prize money being awarded Sunday to a partnership of four Long Islanders in the World Series of Harness Handicapping.

Northfield general manager Tom Aldrich told The Associated Press that the track's lawyers have been consulted. "We are not only looking at this from a legal standpoint, but from a moral and ethical one as well. Right now we are going over all of the state's gaming laws and records of the contest."

The four men - William Garb of Seaford, Richard Stiles of Old Westbury, Kevin Coll of Westbury and Jack Amiot of Jackson Heights — are denying they created artificial odds by making real bets on longshots to hike the odds and payoff pools of their picks in the contest. Garb, who won the contest, and Stiles, who finished third, qualified for \$120,000 of the \$175,000 in prize money. The men reportedly bet \$7,800. The track is checking into one of the highest three-way composite show boards in is history — \$52.80, \$17.80 and \$41.60. Garb's pivotal contest bet was \$1,100 to show on the \$17.80 horse.

Amiot said the foursome did nothing wrong. "We did everything written within the framework of the contest," he said. "We took a heckuva gamble with our own money and it paid off."

#### Kings Beat Oilers, Close In on 2nd
