Ben's Doctor, Lewis: Steroid Use Rampant

Statements to the widespread use of steroids were offered yesterday by sprinter Ben Johnson's doctor and by Johnson's chief rival, Carl Lewis.

"Every athlete in Seoul was on them," Dr. Jamie Astaphan said in a telephone interview with The Associated Press from his home on the Caribbean island of St. Kitts. He also said the International Olympic Committee should lift its ban on the muscle-building drugs.

Astaphan, reported to have administered steroids to Johnson, who was stripped of a gold medal after testing positive for the steroid stanozolol, said his name had been "splattered and smeared" at the Canadian drug inquiry in Toronto.

"But regardless of what has been said, I'll tell the truth when I testify myself," he said.

Lewis told members of the House Judiciary Committee's crime subcommittee that he was certain Johnson was not the only medal-winner who used steroids.

"I would say at least five to 10 if I had to guess . . . and some of those were gold medals," Lewis said.

Temple Voided Palmer's Records

Temple University was so ashamed after learning that All-America running back Paul Palmer signed a professional representation contract while eligible for college play that it forfeited six 1986 victories and voided Palmer's records, the university's president said.

After testifying in the racketeering and extortion trial of New York-based sports agents Norby Walters and Lloyd Bloom, in Chicago, Temple president Peter Liacouras said outside the courtroom, "After we learned what happened, it seemed like the only fair thing to do."

Government prosecutors charge Palmer, now with the Kansas City Chiefs, signed a representation contract with Walters and Bloom in June, 1986, but agreed to conceal the agreement by postdating the pact to January, 1987.

'Fridge' Weight Woes Continue

Bears defensive lineman William Perry is back up to about 360 pounds and may return to a center for eating disorders, coach Mike Ditka said. Perry probably will have to get down to 320 again in order to be invited to training camp July 28, Ditka said . . . The Jets announced the signing of linebacker Jackie Walker, a free agent who played the past three seasons with the Buccaneers. Walker, a 6-5, 255-pounder from Jackson State, was Tampa Bay's second-round draft pick in 1986.

Title Shot for Patterson's Son

Tracy Harris Patterson will get a shot at the WBC featherweight title against Stevie Cruz, according to managers for both boxers. Former heavyweight champion Floyd Patterson said his adopted son, who has a 29-1 record, will fight Cruz for the title May 14 and that negotiations are under way to stage the bout in Atlantic City. Cruz, 25, has a 32-3 record . . . Junior middleweight Roy Jones Jr., who lost a controversial gold-medal bout at the Seoul Olympics, will have the business end of his professional career guided by Harold Rossfield Smith, a former boxing promoter who was convicted of embezzling \$21.3 million from the Wells Fargo Bank of California.

College Sports

Army (6-4) scored three unearned runs on four errors by John Jay (1-5) in the fifth inning, breaking a 2-2 tie en route to a 6-2 college baseball victory. Anthony Cestari had two hits and an RBI for John Jay . . . Chris Ceruti went 2-for-5 with a triple and four RBI and winning pitcher Jennifer Davidson homered to lead LIU (1-0) to a 15-1 softball win over Brooklyn (1-1). Davidson gave up two hits in six innings, striking out seven . . . Fordham's football program, which in 1990 will move to Division I-AA from Division III, made three staff changes yesterday. Jim Kubacki resigned as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach to pursue outside interests. Part-time assistant defensive line coach Tom Schaller was elevated to full-time, and Steff Kruck was named a full-time assistant as quarterbacks and receivers coach.

Forsman Leads New Orleans Golf

Dan Forsman shot an opening-round 6-under-par 66 to take a two-stroke lead over a group of six golfers in the \$750,000 USF & G Classic in New Orleans . . . Allison Finney shot a 7-under-par 66 for a two-shot lead over Beth Daniel after the first round of the \$400,000 LPGA Turquoise Classic in Phoenix.
