Sabatini, Evert Reach Players Tennis Final

Top seed Gabriela Sabatini and No. 2 Chris Evert advanced to the women's final of the International Players Championships in Key Biscayne yesterday. Evert took advantage of numerous unforced errors to beat No. 5 Zina Garrison, 6-3, 6-1, in 75 minutes. Sabatini lost a set for the first time in six tournament matches but beat No. 3 Helena Sukova, 6-7 (2-7), 6-3, 6-4. Evert and Sabatini play for the championship tomorrow.

Inkster Leads Dinah Shore

Julie Inkster shot a 6-under-par 66 to take the opening-day lead in the \$500,000 LPGA Dinah Shore tournament in Rancho Mirage, Calif. She held a two-shot lead over Dale Eggeling. Beth Daniel, Lori Garbacz, Jody Rosenthal and Liselotte Neumann of Sweden were another stroke back. . . . Mike Donald, seeking his first victory in nine seasons on the PGA Tour, shot a 5-under-par 67 to take a one-shot first-round lead in the \$800,000 Independent Insurance Agent Open in The Woodlands, Texas. Brad Faxon and Mike Hulbert shot 68s.

Bears Offer Childress 5-Year Contract

The Bears have offered a five-year contract to All-Pro defensive end Ray Childress. The Oilers have a week to match the offer, details of which were not disclosed. The offer was announced hours after Bears defensive end Al Harris signed with the Eagles. . . . Giants punter Maury Buford, an unprotected free agent who was the third-leading punter in the NFC last season, averaging 41.3 yards a kick, has been signed by the Packers. . . . The Falcons picked up former Giants tight end Danta Whitaker. . . . Dolphins fullback Woody Bennett received the maximum fine of \$5,000 after he pleaded guilty to furnishing alcohol to minors at his York, Pa., restaurant.

Domestic Troubles

Buccaneers quarterback Vinny Testaverde has filed for divorce from his wife of eight months and has asked that a lump-sum alimony payment be a condition of the settlement, according to court records. A document filed in the clerk's office of Hillsborough Circuit Court in Tampa said Testaverde and his wife, Laura, have been estranged since Jan. 26. . . . In Los Angeles, O.J. Simpson pleaded innocent through his attorney to misdemeanor charges that he beat his wife during a New Year's Day dispute at their Brentwood, Calif., home. Simpson will not have to appear for his court trial on April 10.

Kimball Appeal Rejected

Former Olympic diver Bruce Kimball publicly admitted addiction to drugs and alcohol but failed to persuade a judge in Tampa reduce his 17-year prison term or transfer him to a private rehabilitation center. The 1984 silver medalist was sentenced Jan. 30 for killing two teenagers and injuring four others while driving drunk last summer.

College Sports

Junior Dave Mandell of Columbia defeated Dave Stollman of Pennsylvania, 10-8, and Pete Cox of Penn State, 10-6, in the sabre competition to gain second place on the first day of the NCAA men's fencing championships in Evanston, Ill. After beating Cox in the first of a double elimination, Mandell lost to Cox, 10-7, in the final. Mandell was named first team All-America, while teammate Chris Reohr finished seventh. Columbia (29 points) was in second place behind Penn State (30). . . . Jim Perduto scored five goals and Jim DeMarinis added three as Maritime (1-3) trounced Manhattanville, 15-4, in lacrosse. . . . Paul LoGiudice pitched a six-hit, complete-game victory as Fordham (6-7-1, 3-4 in tournament) defeated Lewis-Clark State, 3-2, in the 14th Rainbow Easter Baseball Tournament in Honolulu.

High Schools

Gilberto Torres, Ricardo Perez, Ralph Vasquez and Chris Ramirez drove in two runs apiece to lead Monroe (13-2, 5-1 tournament) to a 12-9 win over Clinton in a semifinal of the Monroe baseball tournament. Torres was 3-for-4 and is 13-for-16 in the double-elimination event. . . . New York Newsday will announce its sixth annual All-City boys basketball team, including the player and coach of the year, in Sunday's editions. The team features the 12 top players in the city, as selected by the staff with the help of city coaches.

University of Colorado starting quarterback Sal Aunese is hospitalized with stomach cancer, which has spread to one of his lungs. Dr. Wayne Gersoff said Aunese, 20, is scheduled to begin chemotherapy treatments next week at University Hospital. Gersoff said Aunese has a "good-sized tumor" that is inoperable. . . . Attorneys for Norby Walters and Lloyd Bloom, sports agents charged with multiple counts of racketeering and fraud, wrapped up the case for the defense in Chicago yesterday. Closing arguments are expected Tuesday, after a day of rebuttal witnesses. . . . Lionell Odom of New York dropped a 5-0 decision to Texan Brian Lonon in the 112-pound semifinals of the U.S. Amateur boxing championships in Colorado Springs.
