### Veteran QB Danny White Retires From Cowboys

Danny White, who holds 11 club records, retired yesterday from the Cowboys, a team suddenly stocked with young quarterbacks. White, 37, made the decision after meeting with new coach Jimmy Johnson. White said Johnson made it clear he did not figure prominently in the team's plans.

"I'm grateful to the Cowboys for the opportunity they've given me to play football," said White, his voice shaking and tears welling in his eyes, "but more than that for the opportunity to have an effect on people's lives."

The Cowboys selected UCLA quarterback Troy Aikman with the first pick in this spring's NFL draft and picked Miami quarterback Steve Walsh in Friday's supplemental draft. They also have Steve Pelleur, who started last season and Scott Secules, who is entering his second season. White said he is not interested in playing a role as a backup and tutor to the young quarterbacks.

### Browns Extend Kosar; Lions, Peete Agree

Bernie Kosar signed a six-year contract extension that will keep him with the Browns through the 1995 season and will make him one of the highest-paid quarterbacks in the NFL. The Browns declined to reveal terms of the extension, but it is estimated to be worth an average of more than \$2 million a year.

Rodney Peete, the former Southern California quarterback, reached agreement with the Detroit Lions, the Los Angeles Times reported. Peete's attorney, Leonard Armato, had set a deadline for coming to terms. Otherwise, Peete, who was drafted by the Oakland A's in June, would have turned to pro baseball.

O.J. Simpson will replace Ahmad Rashad on NBC's "NFL Live" as part of a continuing shakeup of NBC Sports, USA Today reported in today's editions. NBC Sports executive producer Terry O'Neil said Rashad will be a game analyst. Simpson will pair with host Bob Costas, the newspaper said.

### Late Spill Costs Dutchman a Tour Win

A fall in the final 500 meters cost Dutch rider Rudy Dhaenens a victory, while Greg LeMond held onto second place overall as the Tour de France passed the midway mark. Laurent Fignon of France is the overall leader after 11 of the Tour's 21 stages.

Dhaenens broke away from the pack two miles from the finish of the 96-mile leg from Luchon to Blagnac. But, with just over a quarter-mile to go, Dhaenens fell rounding a curve. He damaged his bike and could not finish until everyone had passed him.

With Dhaenens down, Mathieu Hermans of The Netherlands outprinted the pack in 3 hours, 47 minutes and 47 seconds.

Monique Knol of The Netherlands took the first stage of the women's Tour de France. Knol was timed in 1:53:34 for the 47-mile leg from Martres-Tolosane to Blagnac.

### Bruins Hire Sator as Assistant Coach

Former Rangers coach Ted Sator was hired by the Bruins as an assistant coach, a month after he was fired as head coach of the Sabres. Sator, 39, joins the staff of new coach Mike Milbury.

### Lucky Loser Shocks Mancini at U.S. Pro

Third-seeded Alberto Mancini of Argentina, the 10th-ranked player in the world, was stunned by unseeded Phil Johnson of Tunnel Hill, Fla., 7-6 (7-5), 6-2, in the opening round of the U.S. Pro Tennis championships in Brookline, Mass. Top-seeded Andre Agassi beat New Zealand's Steve Guy, 6-4, 6-0, and No. 2 Mats Wilander ousted South Africa's Michael Robertson, 6-3, 6-2.

Top-seeded Paul Annacone broke Brad Drewett in the opening game of the third set after trailing 40-love, keying a 4-6, 6-3, 6-2 victory and a berth in the quarterfinals of the Volvo Tennis-Hall of Fame Championships in Newport, R.I. . . . Top-seeded Jakob Hlasek was upset by Todd Witsken, 6-4, 6-0, in the second round of the \$305,000 Swiss Open in Gstaad.

### ACC's Top Rusher Suspended for Season

Kennard Martin, last season's leading rusher in the Atlantic Coast Conference, will sit out North Carolina's 1989 football season because of his academic problems, according to Tar Heels coach Mack Brown. Martin, who rushed for 1,146 yards and 11 touchdowns, would have one year of eligibility left.

### Furthermore . . .

Finnish middle-distance runner Lasse Viren, an Olympic double gold medalist, said he will run in the Masters Mile of the New York Track & Field Games July 22 at Columbia. . . . Ian Woosnam shot a 6-under-par 65 for a two-shot lead over Spain's Jose-Maria Olazabal and Ireland's Des Smyth after the first round of the Scottish Open in Gleneagles. . . . U.S. District Judge George Marovich ruled that sports agents Norby Walters and Lloyd Bloom will remain free on bond while they appeal their racketeering and fraud convictions. . . . Javier Armengau, who captained Hofstra's 1983-85 wrestling teams, was named the school's wrestling coach, replacing Tony Arena, who resigned in May.
