Teamster council big opts to quit — silently

The chief of New York's ruling Teamster council has agreed to quit his union posts rather than face hearings into his handling of alleged mob influence in the union, the Daily News learned yesterday.

The move by Joseph Trerotola, New York's most powerful Teamster and a key figure in the nation's largest union, came on the eve of his scheduled appearance last week before Frederick Lacey, the court-appointed Teamsters' administrator who is charged with rooting out Teamster corruption.

Under an agreement that must be approved by Lacey, Trerotola, 82, would resign as president of Joint Council 16 and chairman of the huge Eastern Conference of Teamsters.

Trerotola, who also is a vice president of the international union, would complete his current term but drop out as a candidate for reelection, according to sources familiar with the deal who requested anonymity.

## Fight expected

Trerotola's resignation is expected to set off a sharp battle over the Joint Council leadership between Barry Feinstein, the head of Teamsters Local 237 and a close Trerotola ally, and Robert Sasso, president of Local 282.

It was unclear whether Trerotola would be permitted to collect a major cash severance payment similar to that allowed another Teamster vice president, Joe Morgan, who was given in excess of \$1 million following his resignation under pressure last year.

Neither Trerotola nor his attorney, Robert Baptiste, returned calls for comment.

"Joe T," as Trerotola is known, has ruled the Joint Council since 1966

when, according to testimony by two former Teamster presidents, he was approved by New York's mob.

#### Others forced out

Until last year when they were forced out as part of a court-ordered cleanup of the Teamsters union, Trerotola's fellow officers on Joint Council 16 included Pasquale (Patsy) Crapanzano, a convicted bribe taker and alleged Gambino crime family member; Anthony Distinti, an alleged Colombo family associate, and Gerald Corallo, the son of former Luchese clan leader Anthony (Tony Ducks) Corallo.

Trerotola was accused by an independent investigator, attorney Charles Carberry, of having failed to investigate the mob links of those offi-

cials and others. At an initial hearing last month, which Trerotola failed to attend, Carberry also introduced statements given to the FBI by former Teamster president Jackie Presser and ex-Colombo family capo Michael Franzese alleging that Trerotola was controlled by top New York mobsters.

## Ferry back Monday

Full passenger service on the Staten Island ferry will resume Monday, the city Transportation Department said yesterday. Car service will not be available.

Four boats will operate out of the terminal on Whitehall St., which was heavily damaged in a blaze last Sunday.

Officials said the lower level is now asbestos-free. Most of the rest of the terminal will remain - Ellen Tumposky closed.
