HE Phoenix Cardinals signed two free agents on Friday, but the one they really wanted got away. Ronnie Harmon, a former Buffalo Bills running back, said he had rejected a Cardinals offer in favor of a three-year \$1.8-million contract with the San Diego Chargers because Arizona does not observe Martin Luther King Day as a holiday. Phoenix did managed to sign Bill Lewis, a former center for the the Los Angeles Raiders, and Jeff Walker, a guard-tackle from the New Orleans Saints. (AP)
